
Senior World Championship Individual Medalists by Year

1921 European Championships (Paris, FRA - 1921.VI.10-11) Nations: 8

Prior to 1921 there were a number of competitions that called themselves World Championships. These were usually challenge matches between two fencers each or both of which called themselves world champions. Prior to the establishment of the Federation Internationale d'Escrime (FIE) in 1913, however, there was no international body to sanction a real world championship. It was not until after World War I and the 1920 Olympic Games, though, that the FIE finally sanctioned a championship. In these early championships, each nation was allowed to enter a maximum of eight fencers.

From 1921 through 1936 (except in the Olympic years of 1924 and 1928) the FIE sanctioned yearly competitions called the "Championnats d'Europe" ("European Championships"). In spite of their name, non-Europeans were allowed to compete in them and so these competitions are considered to be the first world championships for fencing. It was not until 1937 that the FIE officially changed the name of the competitions from "Championnats d'Europe" to "Championnats du Monde".

The European Championships were held as one of the events during the Grande Semaine des Armes de Combat which ran from June 5 to 12 and included the French national fencing championships and other fencing events as well as shooting events. Only one European Championship event was contested: men's epee individual. Fencers from Belgium, Denmark, France, Great Britain, Netherlands, Romania, Sweden, and Switzerland competed. The format of the event was 3 rounds of pools. The first round was three pools with six qualifying from each pool and the second round was two pools with six qualifying to a final pool of 12. Bouts were for one touch in the first two rounds and for two touches in the finals. Lucien Gaudin was undefeated in the final with only two touches scored against him.

The competition was held at Luna Park, an amusement park near Porte Maillot. Each nation could enter a maximum of 8 fencers. In the two preliminary rounds on Saturday, bouts were for one touch while in the final pool of 10 on Sunday the bouts were for two touches.

A European Championship in men's sabre individual was held for the first time. The competition was held at Scheveningen, a seaside resort district of Ostend. The finals had nine fencers: Belgium (5), Netherlands (2), and Italy and France with one each.

A men's foil individual event was held for the first time. The foil and sabre championships were held in Budapest while the epee championships were in Ostend. No fencers from France or Belgium participated in the two Budapest events.

The semi-finals consisted of two pools with 3-touch bouts. Four fencers qualified out of each pool to meet in one direct elimination round with 6-touch bouts but you had to win by at least two touches ("as in tennis"). The four fencers who won their direct elimination bouts then fenced a pool of 4 with 6-touch bouts.

1929 European Championships (Naples, ITA - 1929.IV.10-16) Nations: 13

European Championships had not been held in 1928 because of the Olympic Games in Amsterdam. Austria, Belgium, Czechoslovakia, Denmark, France, Germany, Great Britain, Hungary, Italy, Netherlands, Poland, Sweden, and Switzerland competed in the individual or team events. The medals were awarded at a gala on April 17.

Because of dissatisfaction with the judging during the men's epee event, the Italian team withdrew all of its epee fencers during the final round and threatened to boycott all future international competitions. A special congress of the FIE was held on 2 November 1931 to make peace with the Italian fencing federation. It had become obvious that an electrical scoring system had to be developed to minimize disputes about refereeing. A successful demonstration of an electrical scoring system was given at the Congress but some details had to be worked out and the equipment manufactured in enough quantity to become widely available and for the fencers to become familiar with its use.

1933 European Championships (Budapest, HUN - 1933.VI.9-18)

The only championship that had been held in 1932 was women's foil team because it was not on the program of the Olympic Games in Los Angeles. In Budapest, all of the final rounds contained at least nine fencers and medals were given to the top nine places. First place got a large golden medal, second and third a large silver medal, fourth and fifth a small silver medal, and sixth through ninth a large bronze medal. For the team events, first got a gold-plated medal, second a large silver medal, and third a large bronze medal. All competitors including the referees received a bronze competitors medal.

Because of the newness of the electrical equipment, on the average, only two machines at a time were in working order and so the final on the second day did not end until 1:30 in the morning. There was also a small commotion about an hour before the end when the epee of one of the Italian fencers was confiscated because the two wires inside the bell guard had bare spots that allowed touches to be registered without the point being depressed. Two fencers were tied for third in the final pool with identical records. Because the final ended so late, it was decided not to hold a barrage but to declare them tied for third.

Grounded pistes were used for the first time and the Hungarians demonstrated an electric scoring machine for foil. The electrical epees being used would register touches made with as little as 150 grams of pressure. At the FIE Congress in April 1935, the rules were changed to require that the pressure be at least 250 grams as of January 1936.

The final pool of 10 fencers lasted 7½ hours and ended with four fencers tied with seven victories. Because it was now too late to hold a fence-off of the four fencers and Lemoine had travel plans that required that he leave early the next day, the top four were declared tied for first by the Jury of Appeal.

1937 Senior World Championships (Paris, FRA - 1937.VII.19-30) Nations: 20

The only championship that had been held in 1936 was women's foil team because it was not on the program of the Olympic Games in Berlin. After the Olympic Games of 1936, the Italian government of Benito Mussolini announced a program of cash rewards for any Italian athlete who won at an Olympic or World Championship. The Italian fencing federation requested that the "European Championships" be henceforth named "World Championships". The FIE approved this request and the first competition to be officially called a World Championships were held in 1937 at the Palais des Sports in Paris with Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Czechoslovakia, Denmark, Egypt, France, Germany, Great Britain, Greece, Italy, Luxemburg, Monaco, Netherlands, Portugal, Romania, Sweden, Uruguay, United States, and Yugoslavia competing.

For this World Championship and subsequent ones, the FIE passed a rule that each country was allowed to enter a maximum of six fencers in the individual events of each weapon. The finals of the foil and sabre events would have eight or nine fencers and for epee, nine or ten.
